## 1 Strengthen Families Through Connection and Support

Prevention starts with connection. Families thrive when they have access to supportive relationships, parenting resources, and community programs that reduce stress and build resilience.

What you can do:

- Check in regularly with families in your life
- Offer practical help (meals, childcare swaps, transportation)
- Share information about local parenting resources and support groups

## 2 Recognize and Respond to the Signs

Awareness is prevention. Learning to recognize potential signs of abuse or neglect — such as sudden behavioral changes, unexplained injuries, or withdrawal — empowers communities to act responsibly.

What you can do:

- Educate yourself on warning signs
- Trust your instincts
- Report concerns to appropriate local authorities or call the hotline for guidance

### 3 Promote Safe, Stable, Nurturing Environments

- Support trauma-informed practices in schools and organizations
- Model respectful, positive interactions with children
