A Victim Advocate's role is to reduce trauma, explain what is happening, connect families with resources, and help ensure the child's needs remain the priority.

Their responsibilities often include:

- **Providing emotional support:** They offer a calm, supportive presence for children and caregivers before, during, and after interviews, medical exams, or court proceedings.
- **Explaining the process:** They help families understand what to expect during investigations involving law enforcement, child protective services, prosecutors, medical exams, and mental health therapy.
- **Crisis intervention:** They help families cope with the immediate emotional impact of abuse disclosures or investigations.
- **Connecting families with services:** They refer families to counseling, trauma therapy, financial assistance, victim compensation programs, support groups, housing resources, and other community services.
- **Safety planning:** If there are ongoing safety concerns, they help develop plans to protect the child and family.
- **Court accompaniment:** If a case proceeds to court, they may accompany victims and caregivers to hearings, explain courtroom procedures, and provide support throughout the legal process.
- **Advocating for victims' rights:** They help families understand their legal rights, including the rights to be informed about the case, receive notifications, and access victim services.
- **Coordinating communication:** They often serve as a point of contact between the family and the multidisciplinary team, helping answer questions and reducing confusion.
